

Teachers saving SchoolNet Test Scores to the PowerTeacher GradeBook

Once a test has been created, scheduled and assigned, teachers can share the test scores to the gradebook. Under the Test Settings area, there is a box that reads: Share Scores with my PowerTeacher Gradebook. Put a check in that box. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and Assign the Test. You may need to Edit your assignment afterwards according to your needs.
